February 15-16, 2021. MIC online training: FIJI fundamentals

FIJI (<https://imagej.net/Fiji>) is a freeware image-processing package widely used in Academia for the analysis of multidimensional microscopy datasets.

Participants will learn basic features of FIJI and how to write simple macros to automate analysis.

Super resolution microscopy methods are currently very popular. Participants will get an overview of super resolution methods and related sample preparation. Focus is on STED and Airyscan techniques, which are also available at MIC.
